Welcome and Briefing – 9.00am at the Edgar Centre

Visiting schools will be quickly welcomed to the tournament. This will happen at 9.00am in the Lion Foundation section of the Edgar Centre. All to be seated in the grandstand please. The intention is to start this on time at **9.00am** and it only take 5-10 minutes. **Rugby/Hockey teams do not have to attend they can go straight to the turf and kettle Park .**

Visiting schools are not required to prepare anything for the welcome.

The welcome will conclude with a short briefing on key information for the day.

The welcome and briefing will conclude at **9.10am**.

Prize-giving – 2.30pm at the Edgar Centre

The tournament will conclude with a short prize-giving. This will commence at **2.30pm** in the Lion Foundation section of the Edgar Centre. Please be seated in the grandstand.

The prize-giving includes a summary of results and the presentation of the cups to the winning school. A vote of thanks will be made on behalf of all schools to the officials, coaches, sports coordinators, etc.

The intention is for the prize-giving to conclude by 2.45pm.

Winning School

The winning school in year 9/10 will receive the Bishop Boyle Trophy. There will be a separate trophy for the Y7/8 competition.

For each game – 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, 0 points for a loss.
The points will be added for each competition.

For each competition (division) – 4 points for the 1st placed school, 3 points for the 2nd placed school, 2 points for the 3rd placed school, 1 point for the 4th placed school.

All competition points will then be added, and the school with the most points will be the winning school.

First Aid

The first aid needs of individual teams and schools are the responsibility of that school.

Ice will be available / provided at both Kettle Park and the Edgar Centre.

A sports medic will be present at Kettle Park and the Edgar Centre.

In an emergency 111 should be used.

Risk Management

Risk management documentation is the individual responsibility of each school.

Food

Lunch is not provided. It is expected that students will bring their own packed lunch.

The Edgar Centre will run a simple canteen during the day. Please promote this to your students.

Light food will be provided for officials and staff. This will be located in the club rooms at Kettle Park (Dunedin Rugby Club), and in Lounge 1 in the Lion Foundation Arena at the Edgar Centre.

Umpires/ Referees

Each School needs to supply 4 Netball and 4 Basketball Referees, at least 1 Hockey umpire please. Trinity will supply the Rugby and Futsal Referees.

Postponement/Cancellation

There isn't a postponement date for this tournament. The only sport that may be cancelled is Rugby/Hockey, all other sports are indoors.

The tournament will only be cancelled in the event of the Dunedin City Council grounds being closed, or due to an extremely poor weather forecast. If cancellation is needed it will happen the evening before by phone call to the sports coordinators and teachers in charge.

Rugby players should come prepared for the possibility of wet and cold weather – warm clothes, towels etc.

COST

Each school will be invoiced for \$5.00 per student for the hire of the Edgar Centre for the day. Each School will also be invoiced for their share of the Hockey turf and the medics for the day.

***Simplified Laws of the Game-**

**This is a guide and should be read in conjunction with the full FIFA Laws of the Game.*

- Futsal is commonly played on netball or basketball sized court in NZ with a goal measuring 3x2 metres.
- From a kick off, the ball must be played forward. A goal **cannot** be scored directly from a kick off.
- A team consists of 5 players, 4 court players and 1 goalkeeper.
- Unlimited "flying" substitutions. Players can re-enter the game from their substitution area (from their own defensive half when no markings) without notifying the referee.
- There is NO offside.
- When the ball goes out over the sideline, it is then placed on the sideline or up to 25cm behind the sideline. From a stationary position, the ball is kicked into the court to another player. All opposing players must be at least 5 metres from the ball.
- For a ball to be out of play or a goal scored; **all** of the ball must be over the line.
- A goal cannot be scored directly from a kick in unless it touches another player.
- Goalkeepers throw the ball from the ("D"-shaped) goal area to restart from a goal clearance.
- Goalkeepers **can** kick the ball from their hands when not a goal clearance.
- A goal clearance is when the ball travels over the defensive goal lines either side of the goal.
- The goalkeeper has 4 seconds time limit to control the ball, unless they are in the oppositions half of the court, at which they then have unlimited time.
- Goalkeepers are not allowed to pick up a back pass from any of their team mates.
- Goalkeepers after playing the ball cannot touch it again (any part of the body) in his/her own half of the pitch after it has been deliberately played to him/her by a team-mate without an opponent touching the ball.
- A maximum of 14 players per team. 5 court players-7 substitutions. (Local competition rules may vary on maximum number of players)
- The game has a 4 second time limit at kick-ins, corner kick-ins and free kicks.
- A player can score direct from a corner.
- Sliding and playing on the ground is permitted when not endangering a player.
- Dangerous play is not allowed.
- After 5 fouls a direct free kick is awarded to the opposing team for every subsequent foul from the second penalty mark. The foul count is reset at halftime.
- The second penalty mark (direct free kick) is 10 metres from the goal line
- During the game, a referee has the option of using 2 cards - Yellow, Red. 2 yellows=sending off-1 red=sending off
- When a red card or x2 yellows are issued the player that committed the offence remains out for duration of game. After 2 minutes of play, or if the opposing team scores a goal, then the team that had a player sent off can use a substitute to give 5 on pitch players once again.
- Referees have the right to warn, ask to leave or eject from the stadium, any spectator whom they feel is bringing the game into disrepute.
- The Referee's decision is final.

The Court

The court is generally a wood or artificial sports court material, although any flat, smooth material may be used. For international matches, the length of the court is between 38–42m and the width 20-25m. For club/school or other matches, it can be from 25-42m in length; while the width can be 16-25m. The length of sidelines should always be greater than the length of the goal lines. A rectangular 3x2m goal is positioned at the middle of each goal line. For futsal in New Zealand, an indoor netball court is most commonly used and is an excellent option for school and club play.

- McMillan Turf 1

- Changing rooms and toilets are available at the McMillan Turf.
- Teams can use the changing rooms to get changed but should not leave bags etc. in them.

CONTROL:

- A control 'wall' will be set up. The draws, results etc. will be displayed there.
- Samantha White is the Hockey Coordinator.

OFFICIALS:

- **Each School is required to provide 1 umpire per team.**
- The umpire schedule will be posted on the control 'wall' on the day.

- Each school provides a match ball for each team please.
